

## **Chamber Meeting**

**Thursday, July, 12.2018**

**4<sup>th</sup> Of July Post Mortem**

**Vice President Lisa Bailey called the meeting to order at noon.**

**Attendance: Cece Davis, Susan Korte, Ron Hundhal, Connie Kesler, Rob Fitch, Lisa Bailey and Joe Gratton.**

**\*Kids Games: Susan said the games went fine but would like to hire help next year for the tear down. She did note that next year the kids need to have a “toy limit” to one bag full. Some of them got a little carried away doing the games just to get more toys. Her goal is to not run out before the end of the day. She will be shopping this year for a bouncy house to purchase for next year.**

**\*Breakfast: Lisa declared she would never do the breakfast again. It was too much work for the little bit of profit. She suggested we offer it to another entity, i.e. 4-H, FFA, etc. Ron Hundhal mentioned that Joe Gratton and a friend, Mike, were interested in the breakfast and maybe offer it to them first since they are also members. She also suggested the breakfast hours should probably be 8 to 10 am. This allows the veterans and community time for their flag raising and still be able to make the breakfast. Also that they did not have much attendance during the first hour.**

**\*Parade: Cece suggested the parade line up for porcupines and entries that want to be judged must be lined up no later than 10 am, no exceptions. Judging will be at 10 am so the winners can be properly identified during the parade. Also encourage on-line early entries. It was suggested they might consider carbon entry forms but it was later determined that those are the only entries that need to register. Advise other parade participants to be sure their entries are well marked with whatever they want announced during the parade on the side of their entries so the announcer can read them. This eliminates numerous unnecessary entry forms. There is still an issue to be resolved regarding the “Poop Patrol” for horse entries.**

**\*Porcupine Race: Joe needs new and more orange tarping for next year. What we have is getting in very bad shape and there isn't enough. It was also discussed that the old chamber canopies need to be sold and replaced with newer, easier assembly. Everyone was very much in favor of this suggestion. It will be put to a vote at the next meeting.**
