Minutes of the July 18, 2018, meeting were read and approved. MSC.

Treasurer Report: Treasurer Connie Kesler reported a balance of \$8,296.42. MSC to sell the two existing canopies for \$50.00 each. The Liability Insurance premium will be \$375.00 this year through State Farm Insurance. MSC to purchase Liability Policy for 2019. Use 104 Dartmouth as the Chamber address this year. MSC to purchase hats for \$8.00 each and visors for \$3.42 each for sale at the Visitor Center. both should retail for \$16.00 each.

Meeting Schedules: Members reminded that meeting will now be scheduled for the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays each month.

Canopies: Two canopies have been purchased and the chamber also has three pop-up canopies in storage.

Heritage Festival: Project Appleseed will be contacted to sponsor a gun range event during the Festival to promote rifleman skills. This year's events will include Apple cidering, Blacksmithing by Luke Riehle, Black powder shooting skills (contact Nick Davenport from the Gun Club) and an open stage for entertainment during the events. Skip Barnett will be in charge of the entertainment. We are contacting the gold panning club to invite them to participate again this year.

Bulls and Broncs: The Rodeo Board suggest partnering with the Chamber for a September Bulls and Broncs event. They will be asked to present their idea for the event at our next meeting on August 8, 2018.

Native Garden: We planted wild Columbine in the garden and Dotty Korte did the weeding from June 11 through June 30 and was paid \$150.00 for the work.

School Registration: The Chamber has been asked for volunteers to help with school registration in August.
